
How to view Web Maps and add features (ArcGIS Online account not required):

1. Click one of the Web Map links listed in this document OR type it directly into a web browser address bar (Chrome is recommended for ArcGIS Online).

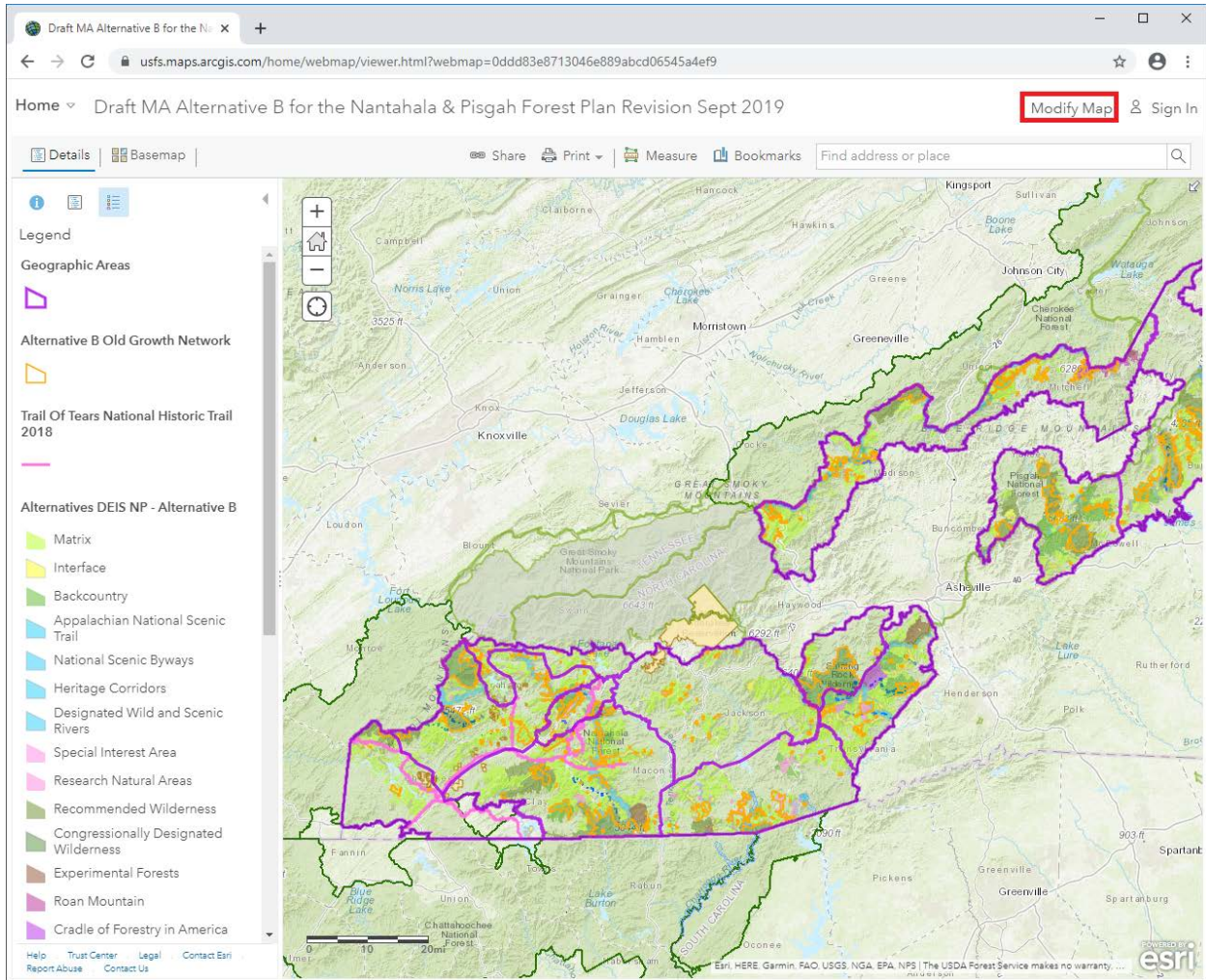

2. When the Web Map description page opens, review the details. When ready to view the Web Map, click the button for "Open in Map Viewer" (highlighted in red in the screen capture below).

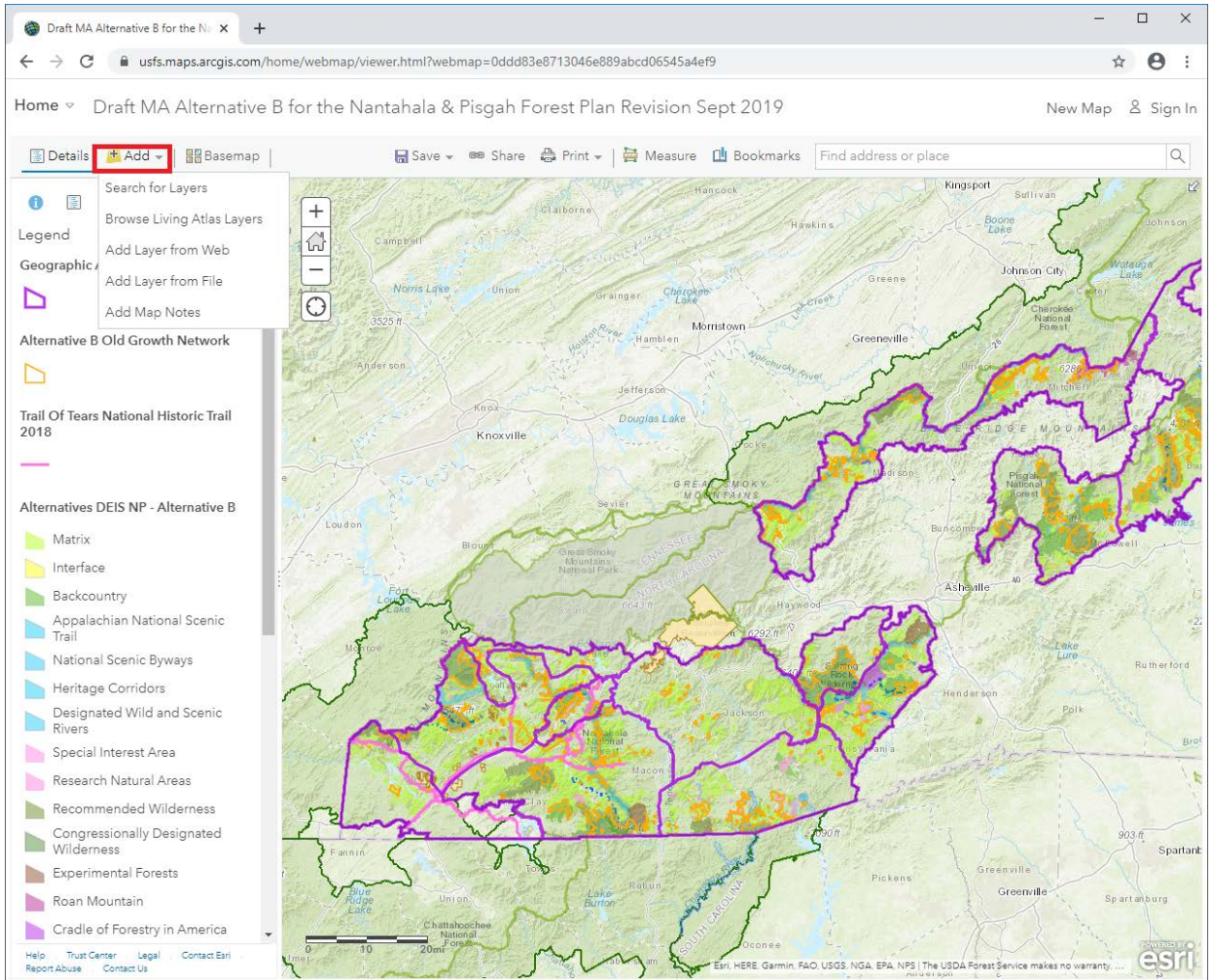

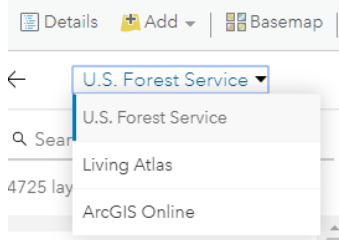
3. When the Web Map fully opens, it will look like the image below. Click “Modify Map” (highlighted in red below) to enable adding other features.



- When the page refreshes, there will be an “Add” button, highlighted in red below. Click on the “Add” button to add publicly available spatial features.






“Search for Layers” opens a search option to search for all publicly available geospatial data (worldwide) that is shared through ESRI. Spatial data can be searched from these sources:

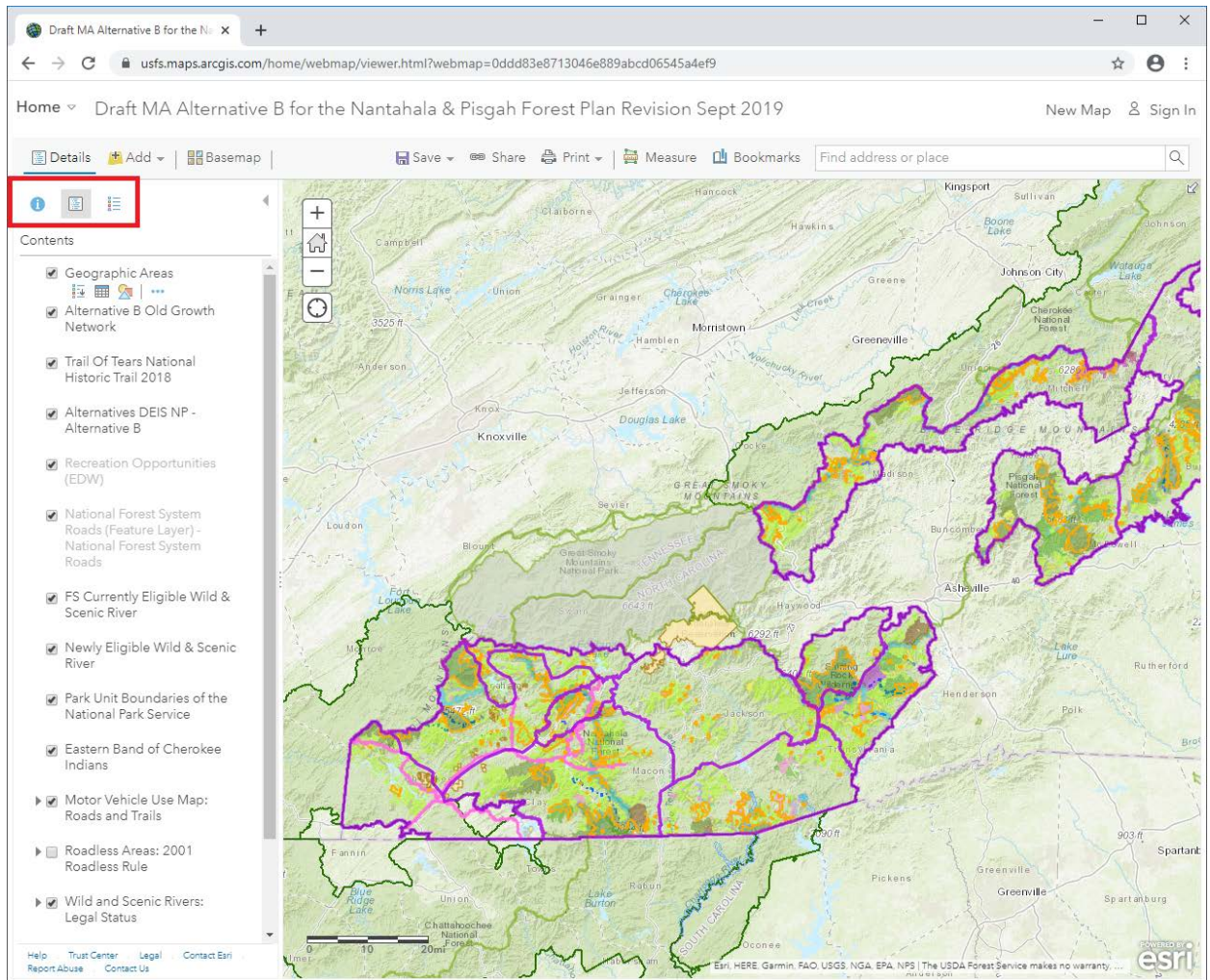

5. There are three icons at the top of the left frame of the Web Map page, highlighted in red below. These are

 “About this Map”,  “Show Contents of Map”, and  “Show Map Legend”

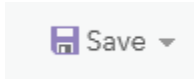


Click on the “Show Contents of Map” button to view the map contents. Click on the check boxes to the left of a map feature to toggle it on or off.
