

National Forest Foundation Photo Contest Rules and Regulations

1. ENTRY: No purchase necessary to enter or win. Contestants will enter by submitting photos or videos (each individual photo or video being a "Submission") via the entry form at nationalforestweek.org.
2. ELIGIBILITY: This contest is open only to legal U.S. residents. Employees of the National Forest Foundation and their families are not eligible. Void where prohibited by law. Contestants residing in those areas where the contest is void may participate in the contest but may not win any prizes.
3. WINNER SELECTION: Employees of the National Forest Foundation will judge the contest. Submissions will be judged on their quality of composition and fitting within the requirements of the contest. All decisions of the judges are final.
4. PRIZES: One Grand Prize winner will receive two American Airlines flight tickets, an RVshare rental credit valued at \$1,500, \$1,000 cash card, and an NFF-branded outdoor gear kit. Three first place winners, one for each category, will receive a \$1,500 REI gift card and an NFF-branded outdoor gear kit. Three second place winners, one for each category, will receive a \$500 REI gift card and an NFF-branded outdoor gear kit. Three third place winners, one for each category, will receive an NFF-branded gear kit.
5. WINNER NOTIFICATION: Winners will be notified via email by December 1, 2026. Inability to contact a winner may result in disqualification and selection of an alternate winner.
6. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

By entering a Submission to the National Forest Foundation Photo Contest (the "Contest"), You as the adult contestant or the parent or legal guardian of a youth contestant agree as follows:

 - a. You hereby irrevocably grant the National Forest Foundation a non-exclusive, perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free, fully paid license to use, publicly display, reproduce, distribute, create derivative works and modify the Submission in any manner related to the Contest and to generally promote and advertise the National Forest Foundation, including all associated use, reproduction, distribution, sublicense, derivative works, and commercial and non-commercial

exploitation rights in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, including, but not limited to the National Forest Foundation's website, social media pages, magazines and brochures.

b. You represent and warrant that the Submission is your original work; You are the sole and exclusive owner of the Submission and all proprietary rights therein; by entering your Submission does not violate or infringe upon the copyright, trademark, privacy, publicity, or other intellectual property or personal property rights of any third party; You have the full and exclusive right, power, and authority to grant to the National Forest Foundation all of the rights set-forth herein, including a world-wide perpetual license; and no rights in the Submission have been previously granted to any other third-party, or otherwise encumbered such that the prior grant would limit or interfere with the rights granted to the National Forest Foundation herein.

c. The National Forest Foundation has the right, unless prohibited under law, to use your name, city and state of residence, voice, picture, and likeness, without compensation, notification, or approval, for the purpose of advertising and publicizing the National Forest Foundation and publicizing the Contest, in any manner or medium, now or hereafter known, worldwide and in perpetuity.

d. CONDUCT: You agree to be bound by these Official Rules. The National Forest Foundation, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any person it finds to be tampering with the entry process, the operation of its web site or is otherwise in violation of these rules.

e. LIMITATIONS OF LIABILITY: The National Forest Foundation is not responsible for late, lost or misdirected entries; technical failures of any kind, including network, server, website, computer, or telephone malfunctions that may occur; human error or unauthorized intervention in the entry process; or any injury or property damage caused by entering a Submission or participating in the Contest. If for any reason, the contest is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention or technical failures of any sort, the National Forest Foundation may cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the contest. You agree to release the National Forest Foundation from any liability resulting from, or related to, Your participation in the contest. You agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the National Forest Foundation against any claims by any third party related to a breach of any of these General Conditions, including, but not limited to, a claim

of ownership of any copyright, trademark, or any personal or property rights, libel, defamation, invasion of privacy, or right of publicity.

g. You agree to receive additional information from the National Forest Foundation and prize sponsors via their electronic mailing lists, provided that You can unsubscribe from said lists at any time.
